**APPLICATION PROCESS AND GUIDELINES FOR PROCESSING ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT (EIA) IN ENUGU STATE**

Pursuant to the provisions of “Environmental Impact Assessment 9EIA) (Act 86, 1992)”

<b>Step 1: Submission of application</b>
<p>⇒ Application is submitted to the Commissioner’s office at Blk B2 (Second Floor), New Secretariat Complex, GRA, Enugu State.</p> <p>⇒ Upon submission of application, the applicant is given a list of State EIA Accredited consultants to choose from.</p>
<b>Step 2: Site visit / inspection</b>
<p>The applicant and the consultant go to the site for survey and negotiate the cost of the assessment.</p>
<b>Step 3: Payment of EIA report fee</b>
<p>The applicant pays the EIA report submission fee <b>₦70,000.00</b>, into the state IGR through any commercial bank and come to the account department for verification and issuance of the treasury receipt</p>
<b>Step 4: Submission of Environmental Impact Assessment Report</b>
<p>The EIA report prepared by the accredited consultant is submitted in the department of pollution office for cross examination /review.</p> <p>The ENMOEMR monitors and tracks the implementation and compliance with recommendations in the EIA report by the applicant</p>
<b>Timeframe:</b> The timeframe for the entire process is 5- 21 days
