APPLICATION PROCESS AND GUIDELINES FOR OBTAINING CERTIFICATE OF ROAD WORTHINESS IN ENUGU STATE

Pursuant to the provisions of “Enugu State Road Traffic Law, Cap 137 Laws of Enugu State 2004”

Step 1: Request for vehicle test

Applicant will visit the nearest motor vehicle licensing office to request vehicle test by submitting Vehicle Registration Number. Motor vehicle licensing offices are located at all offices of the Enugu State Internal Revenue Service (EIRS) and all local government offices in the state.

On arrival at the licensing office, the applicant submits the Vehicle Registration Number of the vehicle to be tested. The applicant is issued a reference number and a payment code to facilitate payment of test fees.

Step 2: Payment for vehicle test and issuance vehicle test receipt

Test fees can be paid via POS at the licensing office or online transfer using PayDirect. Upon payment, the applicant is issued a vehicle test receipt, to be presented at the test centre.

The cost of vehicle test is dependent on vehicle classification per approved schedule. Please see schedule of fees via this link: [Document from Mortal Deity - Google Drive](#)



Step 3: Vehicle inspection and issuance of Certificate of Road Worthiness (CRW)

Upon payment and issuance receipt, applicant is directed to the nearest Vehicle Inspection Office for the test.

The test is then carried out at the inspection office and Road Worthiness Certificate is issued, if the vehicle passes the test. The applicant collects the CRW immediately after the test.

If vehicle fails the test, worn-out parts are recommended for replacement /repairs and CRW is issued upon completion of repairs

Please note that the CRW validity is:

- 6 months for Commercial Vehicles
- 12 months for Private Vehicles

Brand new vehicle do not require RWC for a period of 4 years!

Timeframe:

The timeframe for the entire process is 24 hours (1 day)
